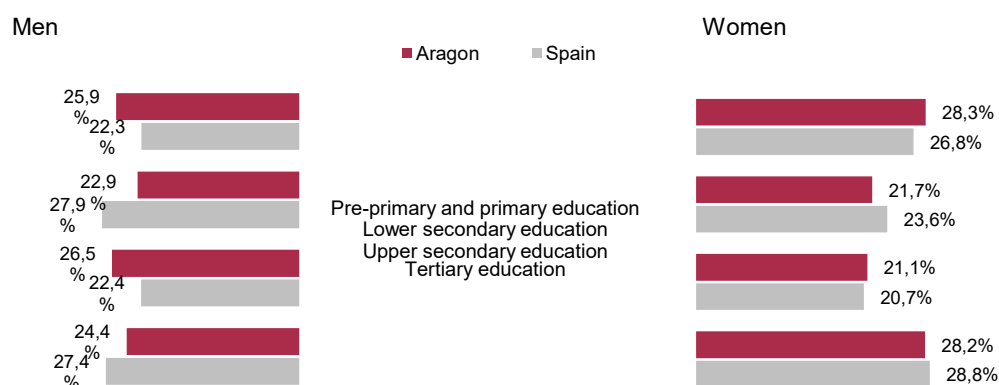

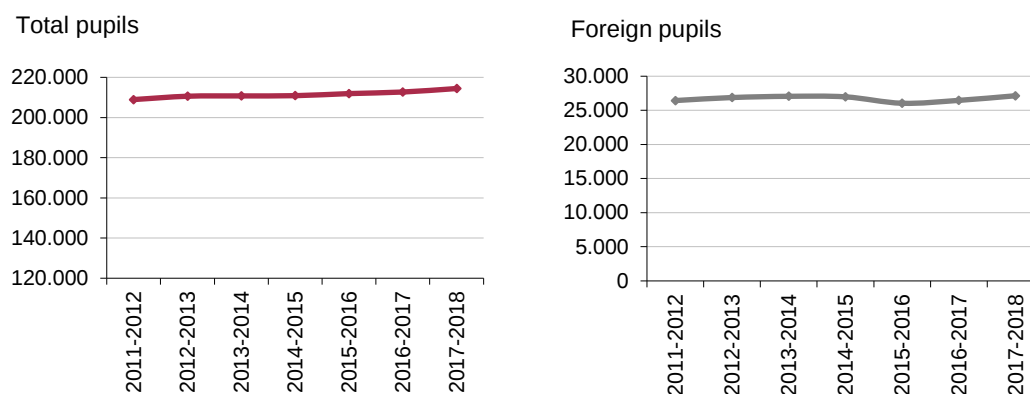

Evolution of registered pupils. Aragon.

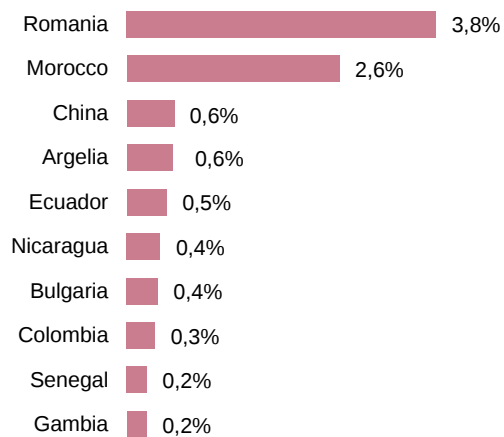

Foreign pupils by origin. Aragon, academic year 2017/2018.

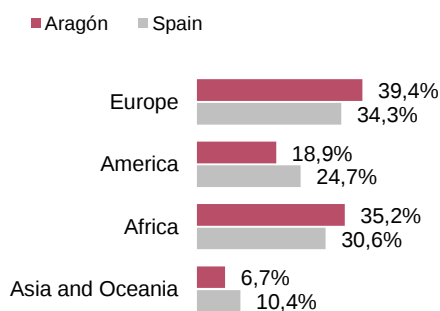
Foreign pupils' main native countries in Aragon.

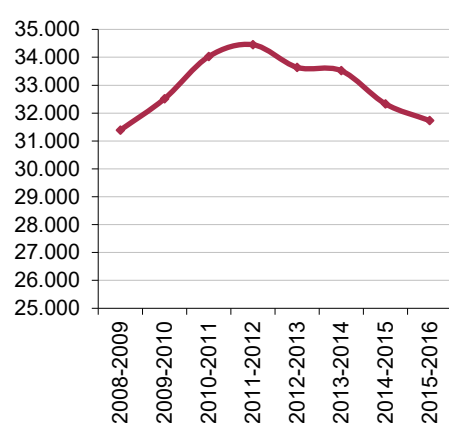

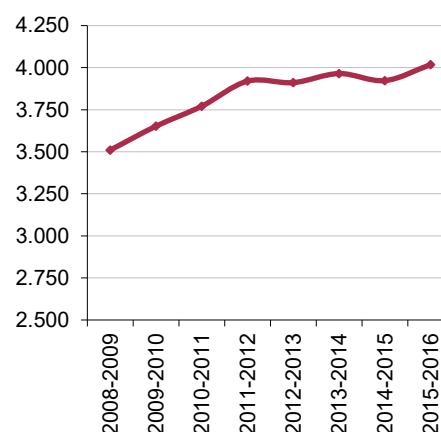

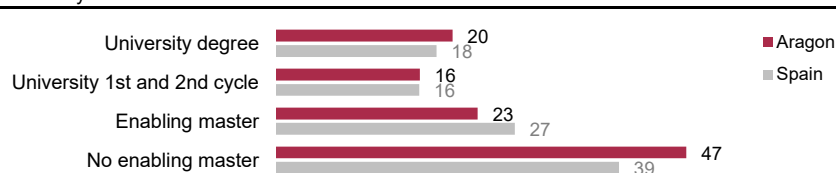

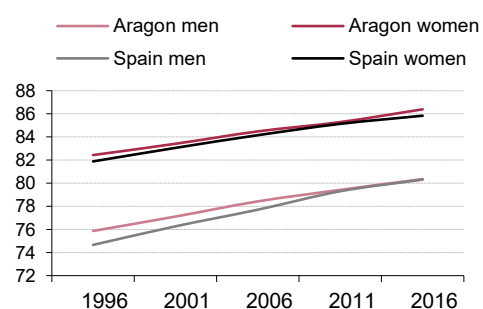

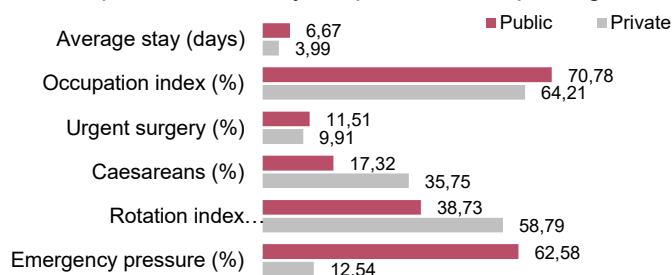

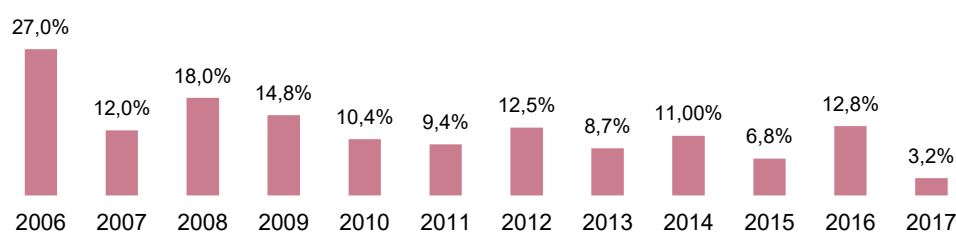

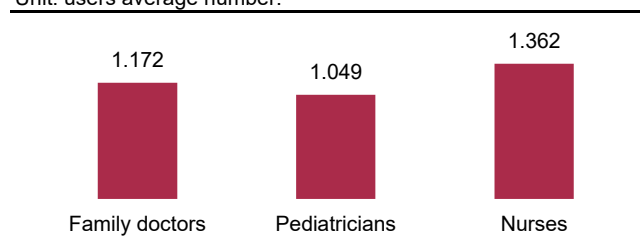

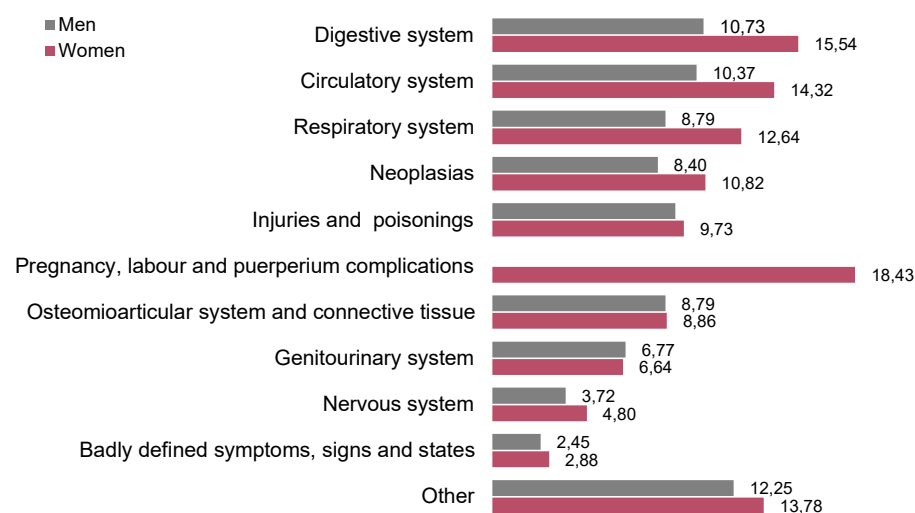

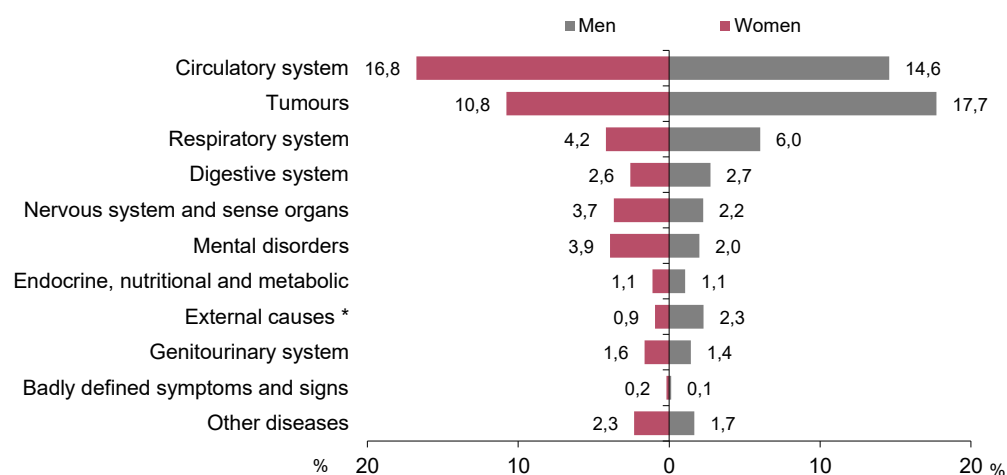

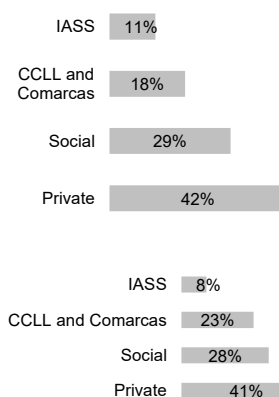

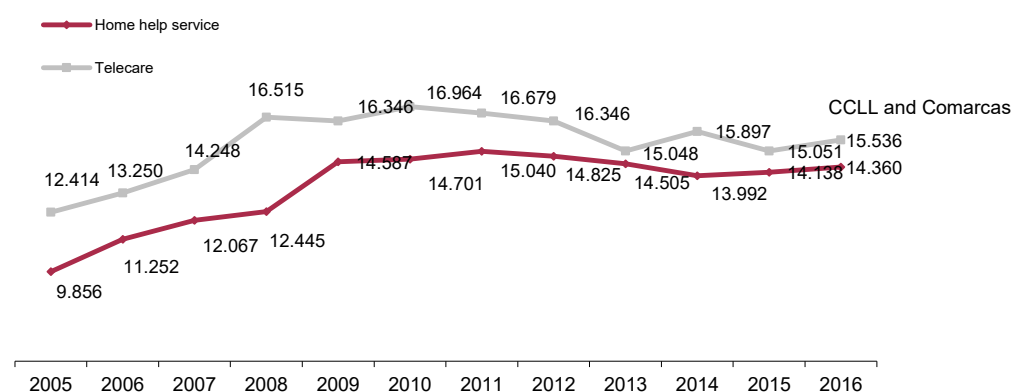

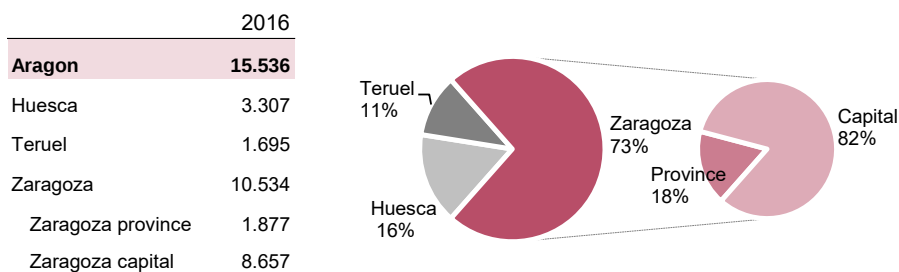

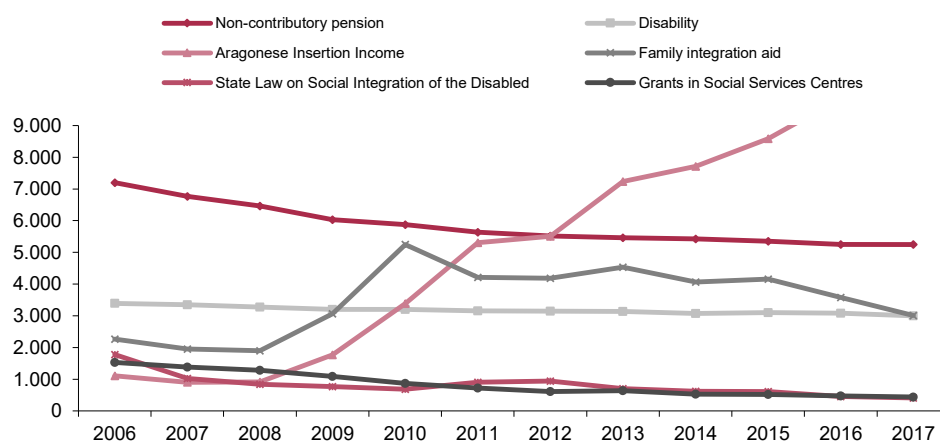

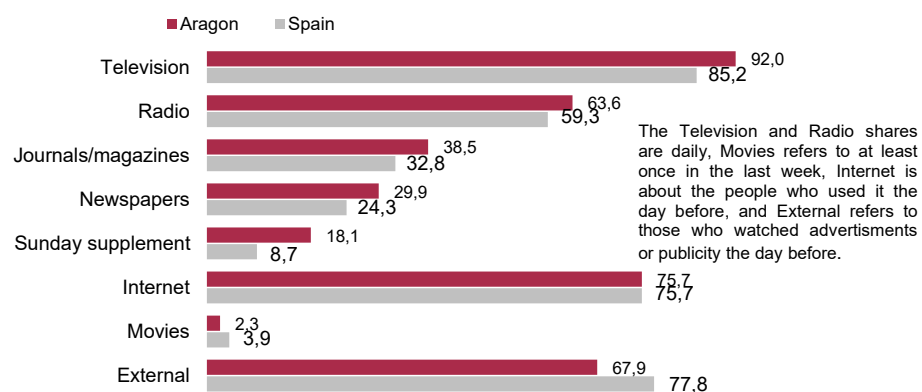

Mass media penetration, 2017.

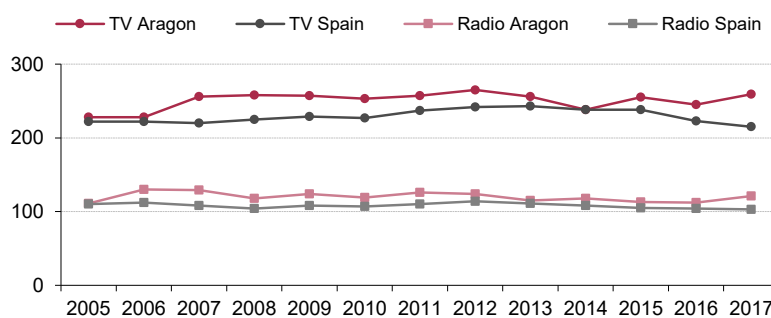

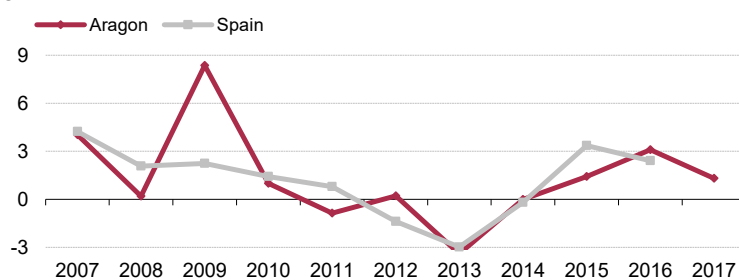

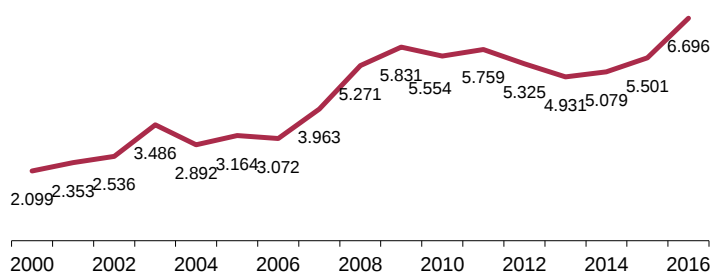

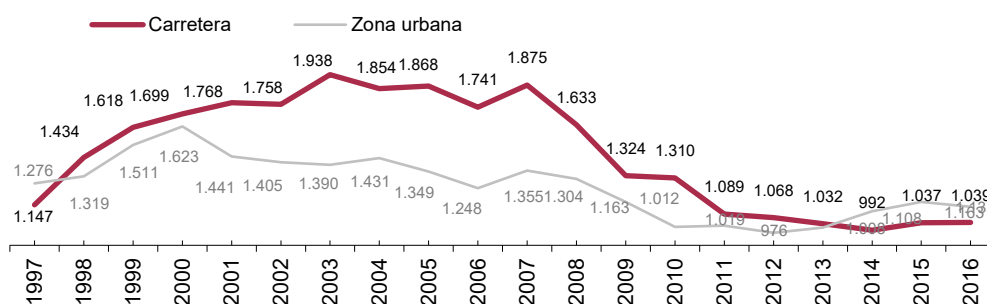

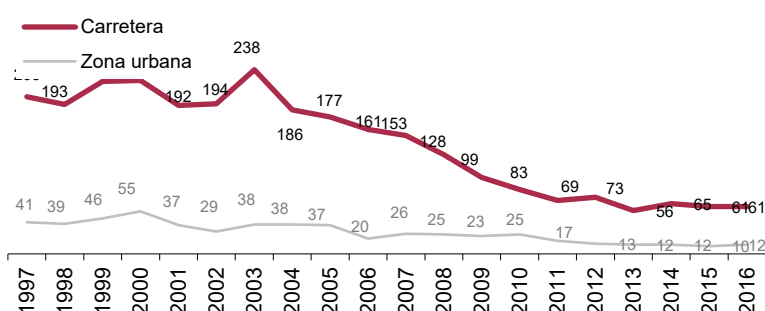
